The Academy's responsibilities in relation to its pupils

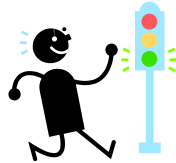
The parents' responsibilities while their child is registered at the Academy

The Academy will best endeavour to –

- 👍 children are well taught, cared for and treated fairly
- 👍 concerns of families are heard and discussed, and resolutions worked upon, as the Academy has an open-door policy
- 👍 parents are kept informed about the curriculum and are invited to be involved in Academy activities
- 👍 parents are offered termly meetings with their child’s teacher
- 👍 parents are given early warnings of any problems with their child’s work or behaviour, following the Academy’s behaviour ladder. Appropriate action will be taken in cases of misconduct or unauthorised absences



The Parents will best endeavour to –

- 👍 their child’s attendance is good
- 👍 their child arrives safely at the Academy for the start of the day and is collected on time at the end of the day
- 👍 they inform the Academy of reasons for a child’s absence by telephone or by letter on the first day of absence
- 👍 they support the Academy’s values and encourage their child to become confident and powerful learners.
- 👍 they encourage their child to respect the premises and the Academy community
- 👍 their actions promote the safety of ALL children
- 👍 their child’s clothing and personal equipment is clearly labelled
- 👍 their child goes to bed at a pre-set sensible time

The Pupils will best endeavour to –



- 👍 attend regularly and arrive at the Academy on time
- 👍 behave well and are kind and helpful to each other
- 👍 take good care of the Academy and their things
- 👍 always show stickability and take pride in all their learning at home and at the Academy
- 👍 do all of their class and home learning as well as they can
- 👍 tell a teacher if anything is worrying them
- 👍 go to bed at a sensible time
