




Home Academy Agreement

The Academy will try to make sure that:

- ☞ children are well taught, cared for and treated fairly;
- ☞ a safe, secure environment supports all children to learn and manage their behaviour;
- ☞ concerns of families are heard and discussed, and resolutions worked upon, as the Academy has an open-door policy;
- ☞ parents are kept informed about the curriculum and are offered opportunities to be involved in the life of the school;
- ☞ opportunities for learning at home are provided in keeping with the school's homework policy;
- ☞ you are informed about general school matters and about your child's progress and wellbeing.



Parents will try to make sure that:

- ☞ their child's attendance is good and that they arrive safely and on time for the start of the day and are collected on time at the end of the day;
- ☞ their child wears correct uniform and has the equipment they need;
- ☞ they inform the Academy of reasons for a child's absence by telephone on the first day of absence;
- ☞ they support the Academy's values and encourage their child to become a confident and powerful learner and to uphold the school rules;
- ☞ they support and encourage home learning;
- ☞ their actions promote the safety of ALL children;
- ☞ their child goes to bed at a sensible time;
- ☞ they work in partnership with the school and support the actions of the school (particularly in front of my child) following the relevant procedures if I have any concerns;
- ☞ inform the school of any change of circumstances at home or otherwise which may affect their children at school.



Pupils will try to make sure that they:

- ☞ keep the school rules:
Be kind. Work hard. Be safe.
- ☞ tell a grown up if they have a problem or something is worrying them;
- ☞ attend regularly and arrive at the Academy on time;
- ☞ go to bed at a sensible time.

- ☞ together and listen to one another's ideas;
- ☞ together to promote our children's understanding of online safety.
